

Software Installation version 1.2.0

Preparation:

- 1) Ensure you have administrator rights on your PC.
- 2) Ensure you are mapped to the network share that you will use when loading the software (we suggest X:\ABN - where X is the name of the shared drive).
- 3) Ensure you have permissions to create directories/folders on your network share.

New Installation(never used before):

First PC

- 1) Install the software
- 2) Copy everything from "C:\Program Files\ABN" to "X:\ABN". There will be 6 files.
- 3) Create a shortcut to "X:\ABN\ABN.EXE" on the PC's desktop. *Note: some PC's will not display the file extension so you will not see the ".EXE" part. However, the icon for the program file is a picture of Caduceus (a winged staff with two snakes wrapped around it).*
- 4) Delete the folder and all files from "C:\Program Files\ABN".
- 5) Install the USB drivers (See installation manual included with TriCorder)

Additional PC(s)

- 1) Install the software
- 2) Create a shortcut to "X:\ABN\ABN.EXE" on the PC's desktop.
- 3) Delete the folder and all files from "C:\Program Files\ABN".
- 4) Install the USB drivers

Re-Installation:

First PC

- 1) Install the software
- 2a) **Keep Old Database:** Copy all files **EXCEPT** ABN.MDB from "C:\Program Files\ABN" to "X:\ABN".
- 2b) **Replace Old Database:** WARNING – You will lose any class info previously loaded. Copy everything from "C:\Program Files\ABN" to "X:\ABN".
- 3) Create a shortcut to "X:\ABN\ABN.EXE" on the PC's desktop. *Note: some PC's will not display the file extension so you will not see the ".EXE" part. However, the icon for the program file is a picture of Caduceus (a winged staff with two snakes wrapped around it).*
- 4) Delete the folder and all files from "C:\Program Files\ABN".
- 5) Install the USB drivers (See installation manual included with TriCorder)

Additional PC(s)

- 1) Install the software
- 2) Create a shortcut to "X:\ABN\ABN.EXE" on the PC's desktop.
- 3) Delete the folder and all files from "C:\Program Files\ABN".
- 4) Install the USB drivers

ALL PCs - OPTIONAL

MDAC Components - Additionally, the latest Microsoft Data Access Components (MDAC) may be required. Some users experience error message "Error 430 - Class does not support Automation or does not support expected interface" - If this happens, you must load the current version of MDAC. You may download it from Microsoft or from our ftp site.

user name - ceprovers

password - abnupload

Download the folder "MDAC 2-8 Version" *Note: the name may change, but it will always contain the word "MDAC"*)

Open the folder and run the program called "MDAC_TYP.EXE". This will update your Data Access Components.

Upgrade from version 1.2.0 (or earlier) to version 1.2.2

Upgrade:

1) Obtain version 1.2.2 from our ftp site or call our CE Dept. (334) 293-5200 for a CD.

user name - ceprovers

password - abnupload

Download the folder "ABN_1.2.2 Patch" to your PC:

2) In the folder "ABN_1.2.2 Patch", there is a file called "ABN.EXE", copy it to the installation directory "X:\ABN" (where X is the network drive the program is installed on). It will tell you that the file already exists and ask if you want to overwrite the file. Answer "YES" or "OK" or whatever the choice is to overwrite the file.

3) Use the program like normal.
